EDUCATIONAL NEED

Research has shown that addictive, compulsive, and impulsive behaviors are under-recognized by clinicians, and clinicians may be unaware of available treatments. Patients who have symptoms of these disorders often present to their treating physician with other complaints such as anxiety and/or depression. After taking this course, those working with psychiatric patients should be able to recognize these disorders in clients, and offer viable treatment options.
